- Remove any low hanging branches obstructing grass cutting or public access or touching gravestones.
 - General weed removal as and when need around the building, flower beds and entrance.
- All areas to be left clean and grass free where possible.

Grass Cutting - Frequency, April, June, August

- All boundaries hedges inside and outside to be trimmed to cover the whole property . Weedkill edges if and when needed.

- ✓ General weed removal as and when need around the building, flower beds and entrance.
- \checkmark All areas to be left clean and grass free where possible.

<u>Grass Cutting</u> - Front Entrance of Church and road Hedge

<u>Frequency, Monthly from April through to 1st week of Nov. (for Remembrance Day)</u>

- All boundaries hedges inside and outside to be trimmed to cover the whole property. Weedkill edges if and when needed.
- Remove any low hanging branches obstructing grass cutting or public access or touching gravestones.
- ✓ General weed removal as and when need around the building, flower beds and entrance.
- ✓ All areas to be left clean and grass free where possible.

<u>Grass Cutting</u> - Frequency New Section <u>18</u> Cuts Year – Old Graveyard To Being <u>Up To A Respectful Standard</u>

- ✓ All boundaries hedges inside and outside to be trimmed to cover the whole property . Weedkill edges if and when needed. Along the road side, up to the first set of houses.
- Remove any low hanging branches obstructing grass cutting or public access or touching gravestones.
- ✓ General weed removal as and when need around the building, flower beds and entrance.
- ✓ All areas to be left clean and grass free where possible.
- New grave yard on the right to be kept very clean and tidy.
- Old grave yard, to be brought up in standard, strim over graves and over time bring the overall standard up.
- ✓ Flowers beds use common sense over time remove the small ones and grass over.

<u>Grass Cutting</u> - Frequency New Section 18 Cuts Year – New Area Graveyard Being Up To A Respectful Standard

- ✓ All boundaries hedges inside and outside to be trimmed to cover the whole property .
 Weedkill edges if and when needed. Along the road side, up to the first set of houses.
- Remove any low hanging branches obstructing grass cutting or public access or touching gravestones.
- \checkmark General weed removal as and when need around the flower beds and entrance.
- \checkmark All areas to be left clean and grass free where possible.
- ✓ Are to be cut with 24 hours of main graveyard.
- ✓ Report any damage or safety risks to the Parish Clerk

Roche, Fore Street

Grass Cutting - Frequency

<u>April – September – in line the front hedge of the Churchyard</u>

- The boundaries hedges running long side the Fore Street, from the Church to the first House at the bottom, to be trimmed, allowing for the Shrubs to be seen which are planted half way down.
- ✓ Weedkill edges if and when needed to reduce time.
- ✓ Remove any low hanging branches obstructing grass cutting.
- ✓ General weed removal as and when need around the Memorial Stone Display and Seated Area.
- ✓ All areas to be left clean and grass free where possible.
- ✓ Report any damage or safety risks to the Parish Clerk <u>clerk@rocheparishcouncil.gov.uk</u>

Both side of the road, by the clays Practice and then continue out to Victoria Road, on the left hand side.







Roche Grass Verges From All Welcome To Roche Signs into the Village

<u>Grass Cutting</u> - Frequency April – October – 4 times a year

- ✓ The boundaries hedges running long side all roads leading into the village, starting at the welcome to Roche sign, (apart from the road coming from Combellecks, in this instance start that entrance on both sides).
- ✓ Grass Verge to be trimmed back to the base of the hedge and including the hedge to be trimmed.
- ✓ If need any overhanging branches to be removed. All areas to be left clean and grass free where possible.

Roche Playing Fields - Roche Park, Inside Boundaries Hedges, Small Children's Area, Willow and Bike Area 18 times a year

<u>Grass Cutting</u> - Frequency 18 times a year

- ✓ The boundaries hedges running long side and the top of the hedge. the Roche Park..
- \checkmark Weedkill edges if and when needed to reduce time.
- ✓ Remove any low hanging branches obstructing grass cutting.
- ✓ General weed removal as and when need around the Memorial Stone Display, on the roundabout.
- ✓ Weed the Flower Bed, by the Memorial.
- \checkmark All areas to be left clean and grass free where possible.
- ✓ Report any damage or safety risks to the Parish Clerk <u>clerk@rocheparishcouncil.gov.uk</u>





Roche Main Park 18 times a year

<u>Grass Cutting</u> - Frequency 18 times a year

- ✓ The boundaries hedges running long side and the top of the hedge.
- ✓ Include the Tennis court area up to the football field carpark
- ✓ Include the right hand side of the football pitch, by the conifer hedge
- ✓ Weedkill edges if and when needed to reduce time.
- ✓ Remove any low hanging branches obstructing grass cutting.
- ✓ All areas to be left clean and grass removed where possible.
- ✓ Area to be cut in line with the small park area, with in 24 hours.
- ✓ Report any damage or safety risks to the Parish Clerk <u>clerk@rocheparishcouncil.gov.uk</u>



Trezaise Bus Stop

Grass Cutting - April & July & October

- ✓ The boundary area around the bus stop area
- ✓ Weedkill edges if and when needed to reduce time.
- Remove any low hanging branches obstructing grass cutting or touching the bus stop.
- \checkmark General weed removal as and when need around the bus stop.
- ✓ All areas to be left clean and grass free where possible.

Grass Cutting - April & July & October

- \checkmark The boundary area around the bus stop area
- ✓ Weedkill edges if and when needed to reduce time.
- Include the left hand verge on past the bus stop until you get to the welcome Roache sign
- Remove any low hanging branches obstructing grass cutting or touching the bus stop.
- ✓ General weed removal as and when need around the bus stop.
- ✓ All areas to be left clean and grass free where possible.

Roche Pharmacy Foot Paths, to Church 412/24/1, 412/6/1

- ✓ The boundary and hedge area around the Foot Path Sign, cut around the pole by 3m area.
- \checkmark Cut along & on top of the wall all the way to the end, as seen on the 2nd picture.
- ✓ Weedkill edges if and when needed to reduce time.
- ✓ Remove any low hanging branches obstructing grass cutting or touching the Foot Path Sign.
- \checkmark All areas to be left clean and grass free where possible.
- ✓ Please wipe off the Public Right Of Way Sign, removing any mould etc.

- \checkmark All areas to be left clean and grass free where possible.
- ✓ Please wipe off the Public Right Of Way Sign, removing any mould etc.

- \checkmark All areas to be left clean and grass free where possible.
- ✓ Please wipe off the Public Right Of Way Sign, removing any mould etc.

Holywell Foot Path 412/3/1 – Old A30 Victoria

- ✓ Weedkill edges if and when needed to reduce time.
- ✓ Remove any low hanging branches obstructing grass cutting or touching the Foot Path Sign.
- \checkmark All areas to be left clean and grass free where possible.
