

A Highways England notification

A30 Highgate to Victoria overnight westbound closure 3 to 4 June 2021

Highways England operates, maintains and improves England's motorways and major A roads.

Sections of road marking on the A30 between Highgate and Victoria have reached the end of their design life and need to be replaced.

In order to carry out the work safely we'll close this section of road overnight between the hours of 8pm in the evening and 6am the following morning. During the day the westbound carriageway will be open as usual.

While closures are in place motorists will be diverted as follows:

- Light vehicles will be diverted via the B3274 to St Columb and onto the A39, to rejoin the A30 at Indian Queens.
- HGV's will follow the same diversion route, but with a small deviation to Roche to avoid a low bridge.
